WRITING CONTEST

The contest is open to all. Both amateur and professional writers may submit articles. Authors may submit up to four entries. Submissions must be original and must not have been previously published. Submission to the contest constitutes permission to Terrebonne Genealogical Society to publish the submission in the *Terrebonne Life Lines*. Copyright remains with the author. Formatting: Font - Times New Roman; 11 point; black only; 1 inch on all sides; single line spacing, and blank line between paragraphs. Articles must be between two and ten pages and saved in Rich Text Format (rtf) or MS Word (doc or docx). If an image is used it must be in 300 dpi jpg format. Do not use any kind of automatic features such as outline, page numbering, headers, footers or footnotes. Do not send a password protected documents. Sources must be documented with manually imputed endnotes regarding where the information was found. Entries will be accepted by e-mail attachment or in hard copy from August 15 until September 30. Include the following information on the first (cover) page for each entry: 1) author's name 2) address 3) telephone number 4) e-mail address 5) a brief biography and 6) author photo suitable for publication with the article.
