Our guest speaker last month, LeeRoy Pitre, said that he became interested in his ancestry as a pre-teen, He remembers hearing stories from his dad, uncle, and grandfather. His curiosity turned into passion and with that came frustration with an occasional sense of gratification. Some stories seemed like fairy tales. Could this be true and is there more out there and has been researching his family for over 35 years. In the 1980's he acquired detailed handwritten lists of ancestors from his great-aunt that dated back to the 1600's. In 2006 after the passing of his father he began professional researching. After acquiring

a few Pitre genealogy-related books he found a lot of errors and no references. In 2008, he stumbled on two jackpots of information: 1) Historical oral recording of S. Terrebonne's elderly residents by Glen Pitre 2) Marie de France: A Critical Companion published in 2012 by Sharon Kinoshita and Peggy McCracken. His journey led him to the origin and history of the Pitre name. Prior to the 10th century (900AD) A History of Pistae (Pistrino), Pistrians > Pistres > Pitres > Pitre. Pistrains. Pistae (Pistrino) – Latin origins of word. Pistrians, Pitres = Ancient Franco dialect -c pre 6th century – could mean clown or mill/baker. Pitres = early French c 6<sup>th</sup> century. Pitre = French/Dutch surname, c late 1400. First immigration, Jean Pitre, was late 1400 or early 1500 from Normandy and the name slowly assimilated the surname of singular "Pitre". Pitre appeared in the First Century of Port Royal in 1671. A small number of Acadians, including Pierre Pitre, were sent to settle near Opelousas post in present day St. Landry Parish, LA. In 2013, he made his first trip to Annapolis Royal in Nova Scotia. In 2014, he published his first book "Windows into Yesteryears", a historical documentary about the true origin and history of "Pitres". Pitre family crest (Coast of Arms) - there is no such thing as an official family crest. It was born by individuals as identification of the title granted by nobility.
